PROJECT HIGHLIGHT - THE TOWNHOMES OF MURRELLS INLET

IN THE NEWS.

A short bike ride to The Marshwalk, one of the top scenic hot spots in Murrells Inlet, The Townhomes of Murrells Inlet are the newest addition of multi-family living in the area. Located just off of Highway 17 Business, this 5-acre community will feature 34 two-story three-bedroom units with access from Murrells Inlet Road. With the ease and convenience of townhome life, the Lowcountry area has been seeing more of these developments evolve.

Despite significant local opposition and issues arising along the way regarding stormwater, tree removal, waste collection, project density, traffic, and access, G3 obtained site plan approval. Efforts by G3 Engineering to work with concerned surrounding members of the community, Georgetown County Planning & Zoning, Planning Commission, and County Council, proved successful once again in delivering a far superior plan for the development of the property. The Townhomes of Murrells Inlet are simply a stepping stone towards the future growth of the Inlet due to high demand and lack of land. Please look for construction to begin in early 2019.

115 years ago, The US and Panama signed the treaty that provided for the Panama Canal on November 18, 1903. The length of the Panama Canal from shoreline to shoreline is about 40 miles. The canal is one of the most strategic artificial waterways in the world and one of the most difficult engineering projects ever. Ships sailing between the east and west coasts of the US shorten their voyage by 8,000 nautical miles by using the canal. The expansion project, completed in 2016, doubled the capacity by adding a wider and deeper lane. The toll revenue per year averages almost \$2 billion.
